

ACG Star Scholarships for university pathways



The main purpose of the scholarships is to support new international students of high calibre to enrol in one of the three university foundation programmes offered by ACG at either the Auckland campus (for The University of Auckland and AUT University) or the Wellington campus (for Victoria University of Wellington).

Selection process

Applications are made by email submission to the Admissions Team email (admissions@acgedu.com) and are then forwarded to the appropriate Regional Sales Director.

Applicants must complete the following documentation:

- Application form including evidence of community engagement, environmental work and/or leadership qualities
- Formal evidence of high academic achievement (minimum GPA 8 equivalent)

The Regional Sales Director will assess all applications and the ACG Registrar awards on their recommendation.

Regulations/Criteria

The scholarships will be known as the ACG Star Scholarships. Up to 21 scholarships will be awarded annually, and will be to the value of up to \$5,000 each.

New students who have received an unconditional offer of study to undertake one of three available foundation programmes are eligible for consideration for this scholarship. Students who have already commenced study at ACG will not be eligible to apply.

Country: Students from Hong Kong, Indonesia, Latin America, Malaysia, Russia and Vietnam are eligible to apply for Star Scholarships.

Applicable study: New full-fee paying international students undertaking a Pathways programme of study, Fast Track, Standard or Standard Plus.

For: Fees credit towards the cost of study at ACG (ACG course credit only)

Number on offer: **Up to 21 awards** (as allocated by market/programme)

The scholarships may not be deferred until the following semester and may not be held concurrently with any other award or grant.

ACG Education is not obliged to make an award if there are no candidates of sufficient merit.

ACG Education has the power to amend or vary these regulations, provided that there is no departure from the main purpose of the scholarships.

NB

International students are neither citizens nor permanent residents of New Zealand or Australia.

ACG wishes to recognise scholarship winners. In accepting the scholarship, the student agrees to allow ACG to publish their name, photograph and programme of study on the ACG website or in ACG marketing materials.
